Re: Upcoming Road Closure – Stanground Bypass / Peterborough Road Bridge

We are writing to inform you of essential works taking place on **Peterborough Road Bridge**, located between Bedstone Way and No. 145 Peterborough Road. Works are due to commence on the **27th July 2026** and will be in place for approximately **6 weeks**.

The planned works include replacement of both bridge expansion joints with new finger plate expansion joints and associated highway improvement works. The bridge joint replacement requires a full closure of the road and footway.

During the closure:

- Peterborough Road Bridge will be **closed to all traffic and pedestrians**.
- **Diversion routes** will be clearly signed to assist drivers and pedestrians.
- Access to properties and businesses outside the closure boundaries will be maintained, but delays may be expected at times.

These dates have been scheduled deliberately during the summer school holidays to minimise disruption to Stanground Academy, located further along Peterborough Road.

The road closure will be in place for 24 hours; however, every effort will be made to provide access outside of working hours where it is safe and practical to do so. Any changes to the 24-hour closure arrangements will be clearly advertised on site.

We understand that road closures can be disruptive, and every effort will be made to complete these works as quickly and safely as possible. Your patience and cooperation throughout this period are greatly appreciated.

Should you require access or have any questions during the works, the site team will be available to assist wherever safe and practicable.

Advance warning signs will be installed on-site ahead of the closure, and updates will be posted on the Council's communication channels to keep the wider community informed.
Thank you for your understanding while these essential improvement works are carried out.
